

**DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER**

**WHEREAS**, on February 12, 2021, Governor Greg Abbott declared a state of disaster for all counties in Texas on account of severe winter weather affecting the State of Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 17, 2021 Fort Bend County Judge KP George declared a state of disaster for Fort Bend County in Texas on account of severe winter weather affecting Fort Bend County; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Needville is within Fort Bend County, and is therefore, included in the state of disaster declared by the Governor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of the City of Needville has determined that expedient measures must be taken to prevent and alleviate the possible effects of severe winter weather on the citizens of the City of Needville; and **NOW, THEREFORE**,

**THE MAYOR OF NEEDVILLE, TEXAS HEREBY ORDERS:**

**SECTION 1. THAT**, pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code, a local state of disaster be declared within the City of Needville, Texas.


**SECTION 2. THAT**, pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster (this "declaration") shall continue for a period of not more than seven (7) days from the date of this declaration, unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Needville, Texas.

**SECTION 3. THAT**, pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed with the City Secretary.


**SECTION 4. THAT**, pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration activates the emergency management plan of the City of Needville, Texas.

**SECTION 5. THAT** this declaration shall take effect immediately.
